1. On-line social networks and national security

2. Romanians from Ukraine - Realpolitik versus Nationality?

The actions of the Russian Federation that led to the annexation of the Crimean

Peninsula had marked an historical moment that made the Ukrainian authorities to be more careful about Moscow's strategy regarding the Russian ethnics. This moment had also marked the start of a new phase in using nationality as soft-power tool.

In their struggle for eastern Ukraine, the Ukrainian authorities considered that they should take measures to limit the Russian Federation's influence in the region on this matter. One of the measures was to prohibit the use of ethnic minority languages in schools across the Ukraine territory. This political decision indirectly affected the other ethnic minorities belonging to the neighboring states, including the Romanians.

Bearing this in mind, this paper is trying to evaluate how the prohibition of using Romanian language in schools will influence the preservation of the ethnic identity of the Romanians from Ukraine.
